I am directed to convey the provisional No Objection of the Govt. of Jammu and Kashmir in favour of 13 (Thirteen) Private Colleges of Education belonging to Kashmir Division as indicated in the annexure to this letter for the sole purpose of imparting instruction in B. Ed Courses session 2006-07 subject to the confirmation after due verification of all relevant documents and grant of affiliation by the University in accordance with the laid down norms and standards by the Government / University in this regard. They should start the classes in the same buildings, premises and site as has been inspected by the University team under the ownership of Trust/Society of the College.


The University may consider the grant of affiliation to the proposed Institutes for imparting instruction in B. Ed course subject to the condition that the Sponsors of the proposed institutes have developed the campus of the proposed Colleges with approach road, College buildings and also necessary equipment and furniture as per prescribed norms at the time of start of session in order to ensure that the quality of Education is not compromised.

The fee-structure, number of seats and the process of admission for the course as approved by the Government and the University of Kashmir, shall be binding upon the College administration. Moreover, the eligibility of the teaching staff to be appointed and the salary to be paid to such staff shall be strictly in accordance with the UGC guidelines as accepted by J&K Government.

The number of retired hands to be appointed shall not exceed thirty percent of the total number of teachers and in no case shall a teacher be continued on the staff beyond the age of 65 years. Retired hands shall be appointed only in subjects where fresh qualified young men with required qualifications are not available. Other welfare measures for the staff of the College as provided under labour laws shall also be taken by the College administration.

The Government reserves the right to withdraw the provisional 'NOC' in case the proposed institute fails to perform in the laid down norms and standards and if any incongruity is found, the Provisional NOC will be withdrawn without assigning any reasons thereof.
